Subject: **Medicaid to Schools Quarterly FMAP Payments**

Schools enrolled with NH Medicaid have been receiving additional quarterly payments since the start of the Public Health Emergency (PHE). On December 29, 2022, the Consolidated Appropriations Act omnibus spending bill was signed into law. The law separates the continuous enrollment requirement from the PHE and terminates this provision as of March 31, 2023. Per the Consolidated Appropriations Act, enhanced FMAP was gradually phased-down through the end of calendar year 2023 (6.2% through March 2023; 5% through June 2023; 2.5% through September 2023 and 1.5% through December 2023).

Please review the below to understand the status of these payments for the last quarter:

- Quarter ending 12/31/2023 (Period 10/01/2023-12/31/2023):
 - You will see this payment on your 1/18/2024 Remittance Advice.
 - This payment will reflect the 1.5% FMAP

This payment will conclude the additional quarterly payments since the start of the Public Health Emergency (PHE). Any school with an outstanding overpayment balance from the 4/13/2023 FMAP payment are asked to please submit a check to the State of New Hampshire as soon as possible.
